Amaria is a lady that looks after 11 babies and toddlers on a daily basis in a small shack that is 3 meters by 3 meters. We painted her place, put a new carpet in, bought two new mattresses with plastic covers for the children to sleep on, decorated the room with pictures, and donated some cloths, blankets and toys.

On Amaria's stand, she also has a second crèche for children that are 3 years and older. This crèche is managed by Celina. Although there are some tables and chairs, the children have to sit on a cold cement floor when they do certain activities because they do not have a carpet.

Celina and the children were ecstatic! They sang a few songs to show their appreciation.
