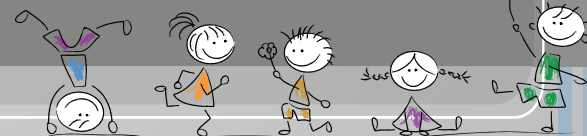
School of Vision reaches Less privileged communities by spreading Christian DVD's and DVD players.
